### [ANALYSIS]

Alcohol | 14.5% alc/vol

pH | 3.6

Acid | 5.6 g/L

Closure | Stelvin

Estate Bottled | September 2019

### [VINIFICATION]

Yielded at 7mt per ha. Wild-yeast fermented. Partial whole-bunch, whole-berry, extended maceration. French oak 300L puncheons and 500L hogshead for 18 months. 35% new. Barrel selection prior to bottling at the estate.

### [TASTING NOTES]

Complex, rich aromas of dark chocolate, plum and spice compliment the dense palate of fresh blackberry, star anise, and white pepper flavours. A powerful but seamlessly balanced cool-climate Shiraz with lingering, leathery tannins. A benchmark of Adelaide Hills Shiraz with the ability to cellar for over 15 years.
